

# BIRDS & WORDS

*A Workshop in Mixed Media & Creating Art Without a Plan*

## SUPPLY LIST

- Watercolor paper - preferably 140 lbs. Or you can use a whiteboard for your final piece. You will probably be painting on this and definitely gluing down on it, so it needs to be able to handle the water/glue. Size up to you – from 8x8", 9x12" and up. We will be working on 9x12" Fluid Artist Watercolor Block (affordable).
- Watercolor paints (tube or pan,) round brushes (size 6 to 10 preferred).
- 2 jars of water plus paper towels.
- Variety of colored paper, any kind of scrap paper, newsprint (you will be painting on and drawing patterns on these papers).
- Markers, pens, pencils, colored pencils (if you use these, bring what YOU use for mark-making).
- White fine line paint pen (like a Posca, Molotow, or Jellyroll) for painting on top of watercolor.
- Fine line permanent black marker (for details).
- Glue stick - UHU is Lynn's fav brand, but any kind of permanent glue stick is fine.
- Scissors (or X-acto and cutting board if you prefer).
